

DGF Elementary School Advisory Committee
Fact Sheet 2008

The DGF Elementary School Advisory Committee (ESAC) is a group of volunteer parents and faculty members who advise school administrators (principal and assistant principal) on educational concerns and policy issues as they arise in the school community.

Committee members are elected each year for two-year terms. Half are parents and half faculty. They meet about 4 times each year.

Meetings are open to the community and anyone can refer an issue for discussion after presenting it to school personnel.

Committee members must be parents/guardians of DGF students or professionally employed school staff members.

The only area ESAC can't address is personnel policy as it relates to individual employees.

ESAC is the community's official "pipeline" to the school administration and to other base activities as they relate to education.
