MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: DoDDS SCHOOL BUS TRANSPORTATION COMMUTING ZONE

REFERENCE: DoD regulation 4500-36-R, Management, Acquisition, and the Use of Motor Vehicles, Chapter 6, Transportation of Department of Defense School Children, dated March 1994.

IAW paragraph 6-10, the following commuting area is established for the support of authorized DoDDS students residing in the Rota Military Community. If family housing is obtained outside this area, transportation of any dependent student between residence and the school or existing school bus stops within the commuting area is the sponsor's responsibility.

The designated commuting area for the DGF Elementary and High School includes the following 4 areas:

El Puerto de Santa Maria

Northern Boundary: A-491

Eastern Boundary: Plaza de Toros

Las Flores

Rota & Costa Ballena


Chipiona

Northern Boundary: Avenida de la Constitucion

Eastern Boundary: A-491

Please note that certain areas of these towns are not serviced for safety and/or logistical reasons, so it's important that families check with the school bus office before making any final arrangements for housing. Consequently, even families residing in the commuting zone may need to walk to the bus stop in accordance with the following limitations:

Walking Distances: The distance a student may be required to walk between the student's primary residence and the school, or designated bus stop, should not normally exceed one (1) mile for students in grades K-6 and one and one half (1.5) miles for student in grades 7-12.
